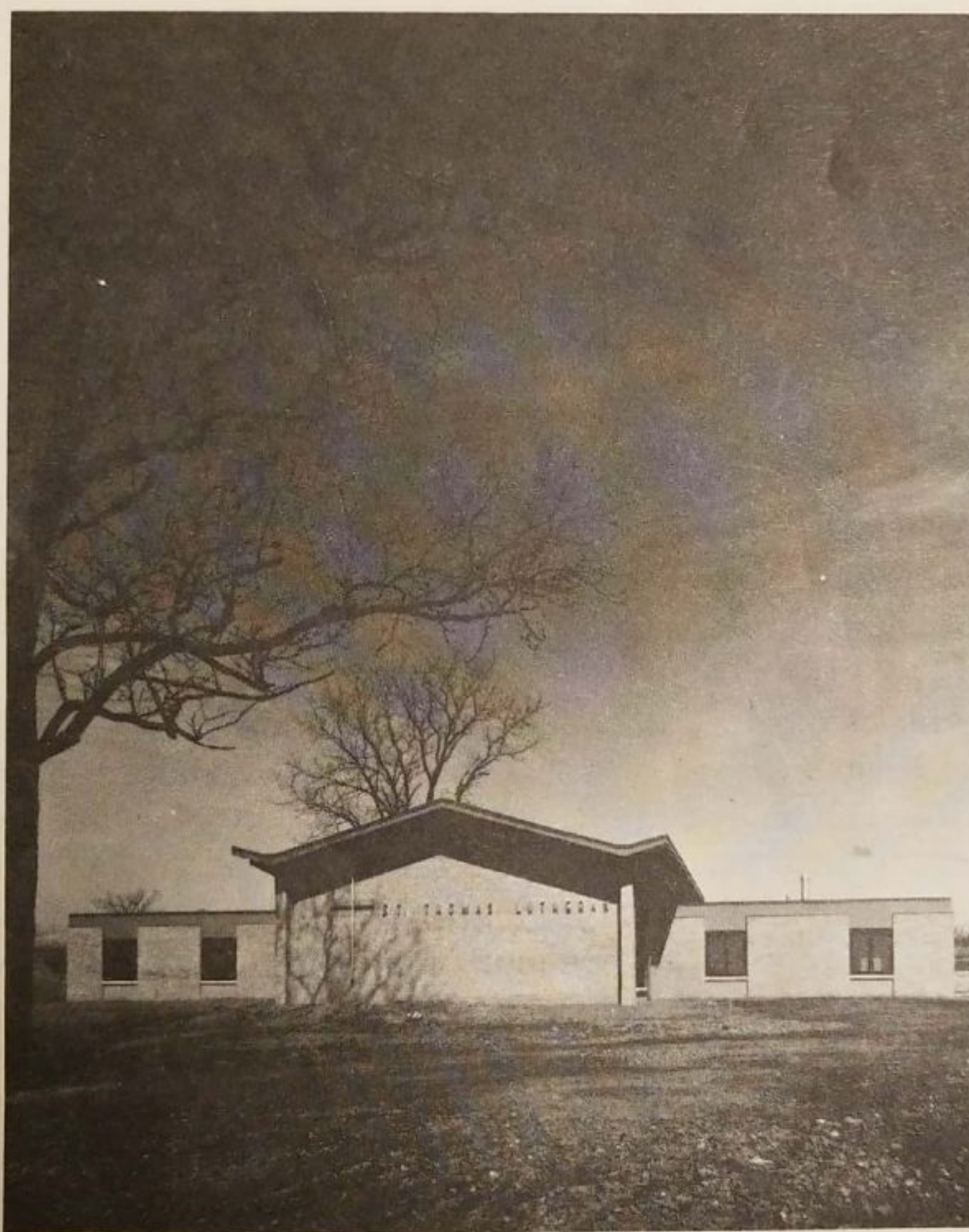

History of St. Thomas Lutheran Church

- April 1961 - Mission Developer Frank A. Miller began survey work in the Streetsboro area
- May 1961 - First meeting of the steering committee
- June 1961 - First congregational interest meeting
- August 1961 - First worship service, on the 6th
- September 1961 - Charter Sunday, on the 24th
- November 1961 - Building site purchased; farmhouse on the site occupied as temporary worship and study center
- March 1962 - Congregation organized as a part of the United Lutheran Church in America, on the 4th
- April 1962 - William J. McCabe called as first pastor
- September 1962 - Parsonage purchased
- May 1963 - Architect engaged
- February 1965 - Fred C. Michelson called as second pastor
- September 1965 - Plans for the first unit of construction approved by the Board of American Missions
- December 1965 - Capital Funds Campaign, directed by the Lutheran Laymen's Movement, approved for two-year program
- April 1966 - Construction bids received
- May 1966 - Church Building Program adopted, on the 8th
Contract signed, with Narzisi Construction Co., on the 20th
The Service of Groundbreaking, on the 22nd
- October 1966 - Final worship in the farmhouse, on the 30th; removal of facilities and program to Streetsboro High School for a seven-week period
- November 1966 - Farmhouse burned, on the 4th
- December 1966 - First Unit occupied, on the 24th
- May 1967 - Landscaping completed, except for paving
- June 1967 - Dedication of first unit, on the 4th
